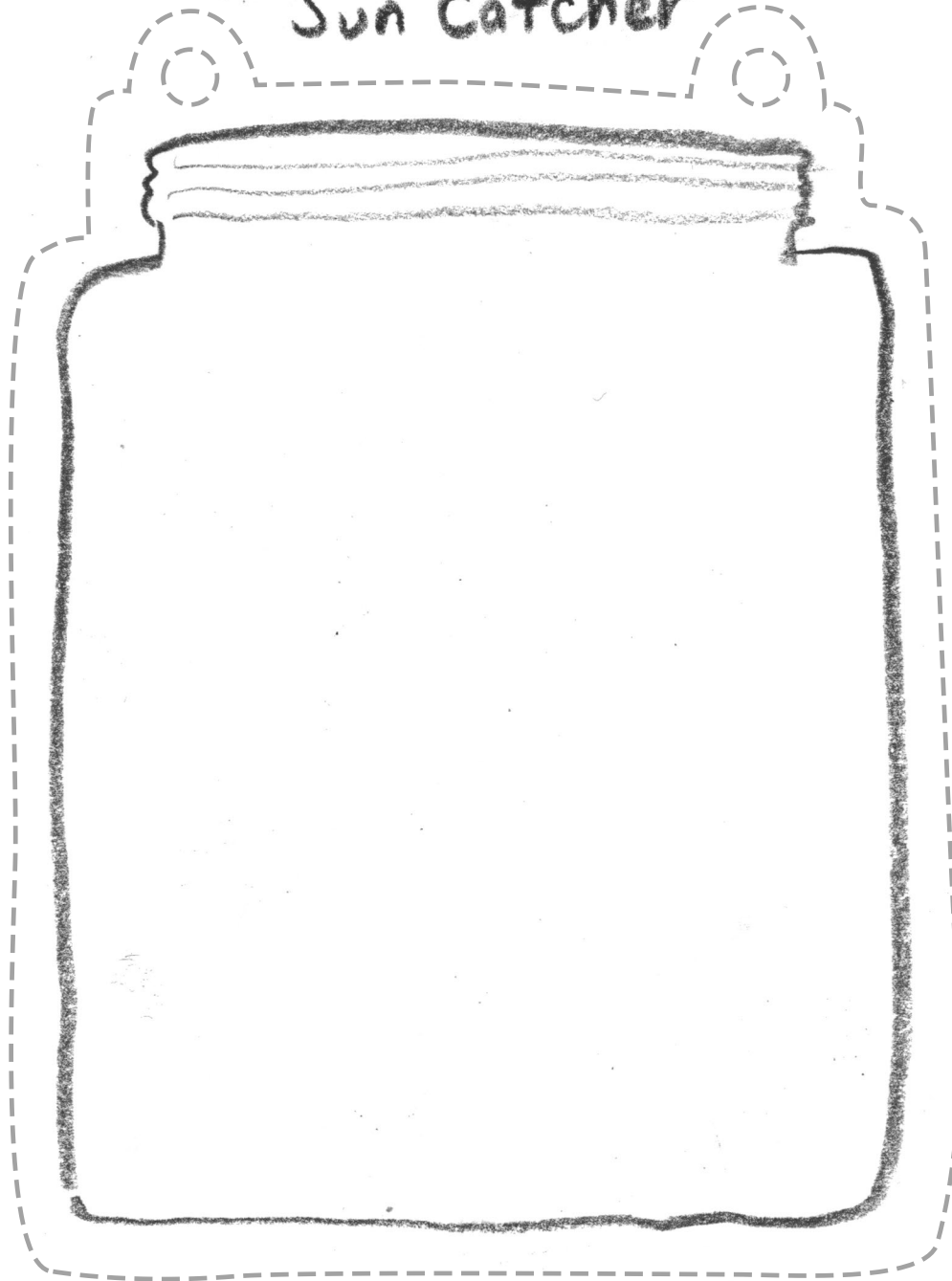




How to make a

# Firefly Jar Sun Catcher



## What you'll need



## Instructions

- 1 Print out x2 of the jar templates (on paper or thin card and cut them out.
- 2 Place the non-printed sides of the jars together and using a pencil and bluetak push holes through both pieces.
- 3 Take the coloured sweet wrappers/tissue paper and glue down on one of the non-printed sides of the jar. You should be able to see the colours through the holes you just made.
- 4 Now apply glue to the other jar piece on the non-printed side. Stick together both pieces of the jar so the coloured paper/wrappers are sandwiched in the centre.
- 5 Now decorate the outside of the jars by drawing Firefly wings, legs and heads around the coloured holes.
- 6 Use a hole punch (or pencil with Bluetack) to make the 2 holes at the top of the jar. Thread a piece of string through the holes and then knot at the ends.
- 7 Finally use some tape or Bluetack to stick your Firefly jar in a window!
